Introductory to Eureka Springs Directory.

Of Eureka Springs, during the past year much has been said for and against its claims as the great healing fountain, the Siloam of the afflicted. Having included this now rapidly growing city in our Directory, it becomes us to give it the prominence it deserves as a great watering-place. The spasmodic growth of this place during the past year has no parallel in the history of watering-places. As the mission of this book is to give a plain statement of facts, it is not our intention to go into an elaborate nor exaggerated description of the so-called "Magic City," like the average (pamphlet) historian, whose numbers are legion, and whose ambition appears to be the panoramic description of the place, disregarding any and all disadvantages or disagreeable facts pertaining to the "City of Healing Waters."

Eureka Springs is situated in the White River Mountains, in Carroll County, Arkansas. It is over 1,750 feet above the level of the sea. The climate is claimed to be mild in the winter and delightfully pleasant in the summer. The nights during the summer months are similar to those enjoyed by residents of the "Golden State." This place as yet can hardly claim the name of a "city"—it is in fact more properly a great camp—although in a few years hence, should the tide of its popularity continue on with the flood now pouring into it, it will soon be far above its rivals, not only as a watering-place, but as a great city. The location of Eureka is picturesque in the extreme, being scattered over the mountain tops, clinging to the mountain sides, and nestling in the great gorges that extend in various directions in the wide-spread corporate limits of the city. The buildings are as yet (with a few exceptions) of little or no consequence as models of architecture, the greater number being rudely constructed of pine lumber, with more view to a hasty occupancy than to convenience and stability. The cost of living is as reasonable here as in any city in the East or South. First-class hotels are not numerous. Boarding houses are numerous and differ muchly as to their accommodations. The visitor can be suited according to his or her means as to cost of living. The streets are very narrow, precipitous and serpentine.

There are in the immediate vicinity some fifty springs, all containing more or less medicinal properties. There are seven principal springs, which have

become noted for their health-giving qualities, namely: The Eureka or Basin, Harding, Johnson, Arsenic, Johnson Oil, Crescent, Sulphur and Iron springs. The above-named Springs have gained a world-wide notoriety for the marvelous cures of the various blood and skin diseases, also for a number of miraculous cases of restoring sight to the blind, and completely curing nearly all cases of sore eyes.

The question will be asked by all who hear of these wonderful springs: "What diseases will they cure?" The following diseases have been known to be benefited, and in many cases radical cures effected, when given proper time and attention: Rheumatism, Cancer, "Sore Eyes," Dyspepsia, Kidney Diseases, Liver Complaints, Scrofula, Catarrh, Paralysis, Ulcers, Asthma, Piles, and other diseases peculiar to an impure condition of the blood. Bright's Disease has been entirely cured by use of these waters.

While the winters are mild in this region, they are not the best time to visit the springs. Between April and November will suit all classes of diseases best. No one need be afraid to go on account of the hot weather. The sun shines warm, to be sure, in mid-summer, but the nights are always cool, and from the great purity of the air good sleep is always insured. Such sound sleep as is always obtainable here in the cool nights of the hot season, contributes very greatly to the restoration of the afflicted. There is a prejudice quite prevalent among the people who live at the springs against the employment of a physician by those who are using the waters. This prejudice does an injustice to the worthy physician and an injury to the sick themselves. There are cases that the waters cannot benefit, or that may be injured by a stay at the springs. The experienced physician might point out this fact at once, and thus save the patient considerable in health and expense. People come to try the effects of the water whom no power on earth can save from an early death; others come afflicted with complaints which are incurable by any known means, and after staying awhile go away and in some instances denounce the springs as a humbug. There are others again who come here whom the waters cannot benefit, and who might be cured at home by good medication or a surgical operation.

From the North, East and West, the Springs can be easiest reached via St. Louis, thence over the St. Louis and San Francisco line to Seligman. From this point Conant & Co.'s stage line, and a number of hacks and private conveyances, carry the traveler over the remaining eighteen miles to the Springs. From the South, Southwest and Southeast, over the St. Louis, Iron Mountain and Southern, the Memphis and Little Rock Railway, to Little Rock, thence via St. Louis, or directly north via the Little Rock and Fort Smith Railway to Ozark, thence by stage to Eureka.

Owing to the rapid growth and constant changes taking place, our work will not be found without errors, but we have done the best we could under the circumstances.

STREETS.

The irregular and serpentine winding of the streets of this place almost baffle description. The following will be of some assistance to the visitor:

North Main Street—Commences at Basin; runs thence northward down the valley to the junction with Sulphur.

South Main Street—Commences at Basin; runs thence southward up the valley to junction with Armstrong and Arsenic streets at Table Rock Bath House.

Spring Street—Commences at Basin; runs north and northwest to junction with Mountain street.

Center Street—Starts from junction with Spring street near Basin; runs same direction as Spring to junction with Berry street near Harding spring.

Mountain Street—Commences with junction of North Main and Sulphur streets, thence westerly to junction with Washington street.

Short Street—From Spring street at Post Office to junction with Mountain street.

Armstrong Street—From junction with South Main at Table Rock, thence northward along the mountain side to junction with Berryville avenue and Douglass street.

Van Buren Street—From junction with Armstrong and Judy streets, thence southeasterly to city limits. (Principal street of South Eureka or New Town.)

Berryville Avenue—From junction with Main at Basin, thence easterly to city limits.

The following Ordinance defines the city limits of Eureka Springs:

ORDINANCE NO. 1.

An Ordinance Defining the Boundary Lines of the Incorporate Town of Eureka Springs, Ark.:

SECTION 1. Be it ordained by the Council of the incorporate town of Eureka Springs, That the boundary lines of Eureka Springs, Ark., be and begin as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of section 10, township 20 north, range 26 west, running east to section line; thence south to the southeast corner of section 15, township 20 north, range 26 west; thence west to the southwest corner of section 15; thence north to the place of beginning, comprising the south half of section 10, the whole of section 15, township 20 north, range 26 west.
